Licking - helps to cool body down

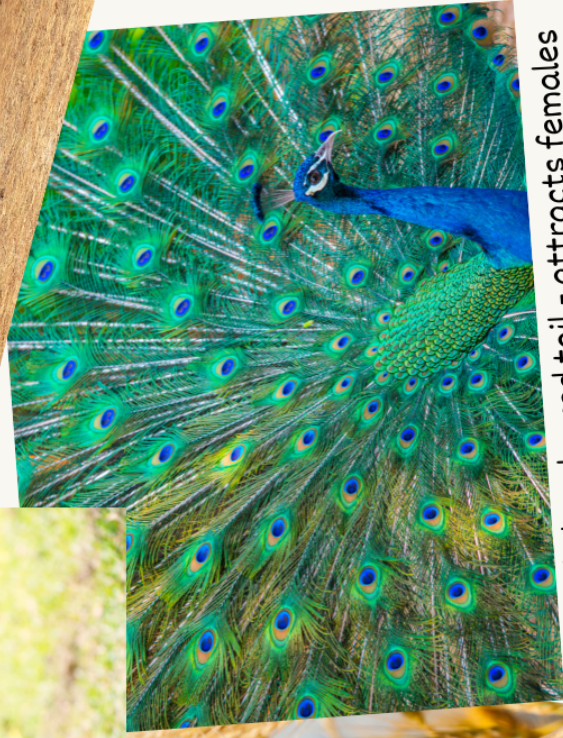


Drought tolerant wheat - needs less water to grow
